Purpose: A volunteer citizen formed ordinance committee will review the current ACT ordinances.

Need:

A review of the ACT ordinances is an effort being undertaken by the board of ACT supervisors to update the ordinances which were last reviewed in 2014.

ACT is a rural community that strives to maintain a country lifestyle while being only minutes away from an urban setting. Hopefully, the citizens enjoy and respect the spaciousness and privacy of their particular residence, and respect the space and boundary of their neighbors.

The ordinances committee's goal is to review the ACT ordinances to keep them current. The committee shall present ordinance recommendations and proposed language at the regular monthly ACT meetings.

The ACT board of supervisors wishes to thank you in advance for your efforts on this worthwhile project. While participation on this ordinance committee is voluntary and provides a community service to all ACT members, the following code of ethics shall be observed by all members at all times. Should the need arise for the board of supervisors to remove a committee member for non-observance of all the codes of ethics, their decision shall be final.

Any and all applicable North Dakota laws shall be obeyed.

- Violating or asking others to violate any applicable laws or ordinance shall be cause for immediate removal from the committee.
- Each committee member as well as all ACT residents, shall be treated with respect.
- This committee shall not be used as a means to subjugate any current ACT ordinance as to benefit themselves or others. Furthermore, this committee shall not make ordinance recommendations based on past experiences or behavior exhibited by others in an attempt to exact measure or revenge. Any such occurrence shall be deemed sufficient as to be removed from the committee.
